UPDATE

Dear parents/carers and students,

It has been a great first week back after returning from the half term holiday and I hope you had a restful break.

You will recall from my letter earlier this week that we continue to ensure the highest standards are maintained across the school. I am therefore incredibly pleased with how students have responded so quickly from the key pastoral messages which were delivered in our assemblies this week to ensure no learning time is lost.

Since joining Bourne Academy, I have been impressed with the wide extra-curricular and enrichment programme we offer to students. In order to provide parents/carers and students a clear overview, I am delighted that we will be sharing with you our brand-new enrichment list which provides a comprehensive outline of the vast activities your child can take part in (included in this update). You will see that Bourne Academy offers an extensive range of enrichment activities and I would encourage your child to choose at least one activity they can take part in. To ensure that parents/carers and students have updated information, our enrichment and extra-curricular provision timetable will be updated on a termly basis.

Next week will be a very exciting week at Bourne Academy and I would like to give you advance notice of two key events. On Wednesday 2nd March, all students across the school will take part in our PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education) day. Students will not have normal lessons on this day, but will have the opportunity to develop their personal development and academic knowledge. Years 11 and 13 will focus on planned intervention to support their upcoming exams; Year 7 will develop their understanding of keeping safe; Years 8 and 9 will have a careers focus; an external speaker will be with Year 10 students as well as having opportunities to focus on key PSHE topics and Year 12 students will be visiting a local university.



We have a number of students from both these countries and also neighbouring countries in all of our schools, and I have asked the pastoral leads in all schools to coordinate a response so that we can ensure that we offer the appropriate level of support for students in each school. What can I say, other than it is just a terrible situation. I have overheard conversations on the yards, and engaged in some, and know many students are genuinely worried about what is happening in Ukraine, so we are considering how to address this sensitively via assemblies and our PSHE programme, and please remember that we have the worried@bourneacademy.org email tab, where students can get support as needed.
