As mentioned above, many of our Year 11 students will be staying on to study their respective courses at our Sixth Form. Over the course of today, our prospective Year 12 students had a taste of what life is like as a Sixth Former at Bourne Academy. The day started with a great escape room activity which allowed students to break the ice and to meet new peers. Additionally, all students had the opportunity to sample taster lessons of the subjects they wish to study. The feedback from students was highly positive and I would like to thank the Sixth Form team for their planning to make the day an enjoyable one for the students.

Similar to the Year 12 Induction Day, preparations are underway for our Transition Day which will take place on Friday 1st July 2022 for the current Year 6 students.
