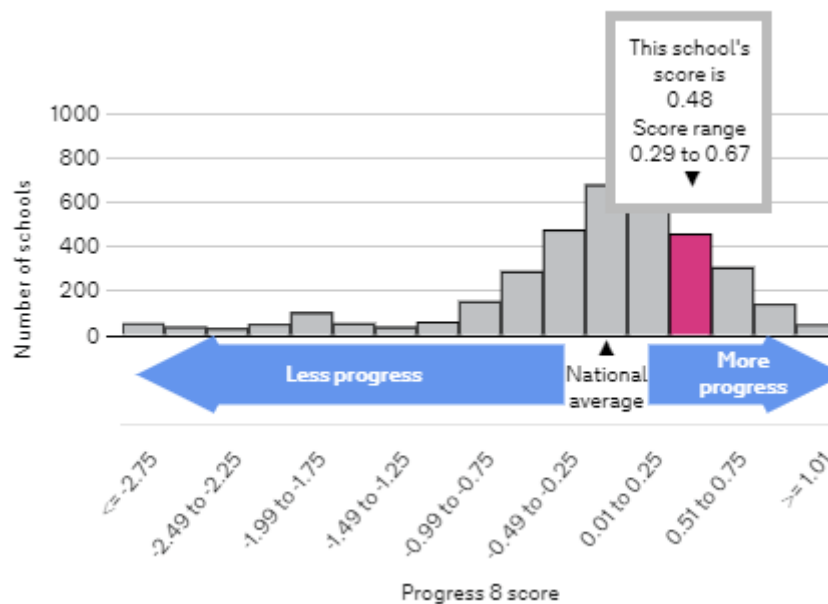

Dear parents/carers and students,

I am pleased to share with you our provisional Progress 8 Score for Bourne Academy which has been published recently on the Government's School Performance Tables. The Progress 8 score is a measure calculated each year on the basis of the actual results of all students nationally taking exams at the end of Year 11. As you can see from the graph below, students at Bourne Academy make very strong progress and outperform many schools, including the various Lincolnshire Grammar Schools. Our team of dedicated teachers work tirelessly to ensure students of all abilities can maximise their potential as a student of this school. Additionally, we ensure our strong curriculum offer at Bourne Academy can meet the needs of all our students, coupled with the excellent pastoral care we provide to our students. We are proud of our students and the strong set of academic results is a testament to their hard work and the support they receive from you as parents and carers.



As part of our daily rewards system, each year group have had their Strike Card Prize Draw this week, in their assemblies. We always celebrate students for carrying out what we expect from our students on a daily basis. Each student with a clean Strike Card was entered to the prize draw to win £40 Love2shop gift



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vouchers. I was really pleased to see so many clear Strike Cards in the prize draw. Students have all been given a new Strike Card again this term. Over the next week, we will also be delivering over 500 cookies/muffins and drinks to those students who have achieved 100% attendance last term. We pride ourselves on recognising everyday achievements and we believe all students who achieve 100% attendance deserve a little treat!

This week we saw the return to our Sixth Form reading mentoring programme. This hugely successful initiative at Bourne Academy sees a Sixth Form student paired with a Year 7 or 8 student who they then meet with once a week for a reading mentoring session. Mrs Bland (Assistant Headteacher) commented, *"Last year, the project was a resounding success and this year things have gone from strength to strength with now over 90 students taking part. Feedback from the mentees has been overwhelmingly positive with many saying that they hugely look forward to their reading session each week and reporting significantly increased levels of confidence with their reading."*



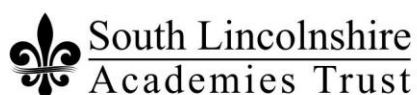
