

Dear parents/carers and students,

It has been a very good week with many students engaging in their practical exams which has continued over this week in an array of subjects including art, media, performing arts and languages. Students have been well prepared to sit the various exams and once again the level of focus and conduct has been impeccable. We only have five school days until the very first formal written examination and we understand it is a stressful time particularly for our Year 11 and 13 cohorts. As such, in addition to the extensive pastoral care we offer at Bourne Academy, we have signposted our students to other sources of support, including useful websites to support their mental wellbeing in this very busy time of exams.

In addition to the lunchtime and after-school intervention we offer to our students (details of these are included at the end of this update), some of our Heads of Departments took the opportunity to deliver subject specific assemblies with revision tips and general guidance to help our students in their final stages of revision. I would like to say thank you to the Maths, Science and English departments who have delivered a brilliant set of assemblies this week.

PSHE is an aspect I regularly mention in my weekly updates and this week enabled our Year 7 and 8 female students to receive an important assembly to raise awareness of menstruation and menstruation products. The assembly was led by Mrs Hirst (Trust PSHE Lead) who also discussed issues relating to puberty and other age-appropriate topics. I am fully aware that as parents and carers, you are always best placed to have such significant conversations with your child; however, the purpose of the assembly was to reassure our students born female that there is support at school, moreover, that we are able to provide products free of charge as part of the national government scheme to end period poverty. If your daughter has any additional questions relating to the assembly, please do encourage them to see their respective Year Lead or any of the pastoral team who will be happy to answer any additional questions, or to provide relevant products in a discreet manner.

You will recall in one of my previous newsletters that I made reference to an assembly I delivered which focused on our ethos and school values. An area which is important to us in 'student voice.' This term, we have launched a new initiative called 'Students Say, We Listen' where students can complete a quick form on our website (see link below) to make comments and suggestions about the school. This is one of the many ways in which we enable students to play an active part in contributing to the school.
