On Wednesday, 45 of our Sixth Form Media students visited the Warner Bros Studios to learn about storyboarding and the film-making processes as part of their Level 3 BTEC Media Studies course. Students had the chance to get up close and personal with costumes and props used in Harry Potter films as well as learn about how to storyboard effectively for film and television. Students had a fantastic time not only meeting with media professionals to get tips and tricks that will help with their coursework but also exploring the studios and getting to interact with props, taking their first broomstick lessons and experiencing some of the magic that goes on with the fantastic beasts included in the film. All students were a credit to the school and it was an incredible chance for them to experience one of the fastest-growing film industry sites in the UK that is responsible for such an iconic film franchise.


