UPDATE

Dear parents/carers and students,

It has been a busy and excellent first full week back after Christmas.

This week, we have been rewarding students in Key Stage 3 with achieving their Aspire Badges. Nine students collected their Aspire Rewards in their House Assembly this week, which is brilliant! A special mention to Isabella Afford in Year 8, who has been rewarded with her Silver Aspire Badge and is already well on her way to completing her Gold badge. We look forward to rewarding many more students this term.

Our Year 10 History students went back in time this week with Time Travel Education to experience life in a World War One trench. Our students had the opportunity to see what it would have been like for an injured soldier themselves through the use of VR headsets. The students were guided by WW1 medic (historical interpreter) Richard who demonstrated the RAMC's chain of evacuation and the key surgical techniques of the time. Students across all our year groups were invited to an object handling workshop during lunch where they were able to try on uniform and learn to tie a tourniquet. The immersive experience will be invaluable for our student's understanding of the 'Medicine on the British Sector of the Western Front' unit of their GCSE.

Our Year 11 Parents Evening will be taking place online on Thursday 25th January 2024 from 4.30pm to 7.30pm and parents are required to book their online appointments in advance. Year 11 is a crucial year with GCSE exams and coursework to be completed so this Parents Evening will focus on discussing the progress with grades and where students need to prioritise their learning to get the best results in the summer.

Year 11 students will also take part in a mock exam results session next Thursday during afternoon registration. This enables students to receive their results in assembly to celebrate success or to utilise the results as a guide to target key areas before the summer examinations. Our intervention programme is in place to support students at lunchtime and after school. All students have access to GCSEPod which is proven to support students with revision.

A number of our students have qualified to represent the South Lincolnshire Superzone next Saturday, at the County Cross Country Championships. This is a great achievement and we wish them every success in this event.

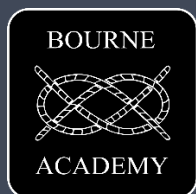

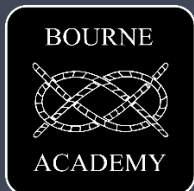
