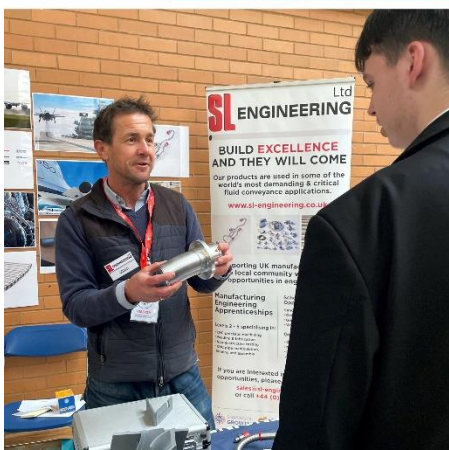
Aspire • Challenge • Achieve

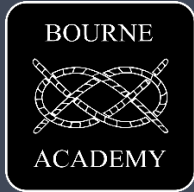
