

PSHE/SMSC– CURRICULUM INTENT

ASPIRE – CHALLENGE – ACHIEVE

The PSHE/SMSC curriculum is designed around the needs of students, equipping them with the knowledge, skills and cultural capital required to thrive in a modern, diverse and rapidly changing world. It prepares students for life in modern Britain by enabling them to make informed decisions, manage risk, stay safe and contribute positively to society. In an increasingly complex landscape, the curriculum is deliberately constructed to support students in navigating the opportunities, challenges and responsibilities they will encounter as they progress into adulthood.

PSHE and SMSC are central to the Trust's ethos, underpinning personal development across all aspects of school life. The curriculum enables students to reflect on their values, while fostering respect, empathy and understanding for others. It supports students to become active, responsible citizens who engage positively within their communities and wider society, grounded in a secure understanding of British Values.

The curriculum is fully aligned with the updated 2026 statutory RSHE guidance, with a strengthened emphasis on safeguarding and contemporary risks. Learning is framed around relevant, real-world issues, including relationships, mental and physical health, online safety, financial literacy, equality and global challenges. Students are explicitly taught how to recognise and respond to online harms, including social media influence, artificial intelligence, misinformation, exploitation and financial scams. These themes are embedded throughout the curriculum and across subjects, ensuring students are equipped to navigate modern life confidently and responsibly.

Safeguarding and wellbeing are at the core of the curriculum. Students develop the confidence to manage risk, understand consent, recognise healthy and unhealthy behaviours and access appropriate support. They build resilience, self-esteem and emotional literacy, enabling them to form positive relationships and communicate effectively in a range of contexts. The curriculum also addresses emerging societal challenges, including misogyny, harmful online ideologies and violence in relationships, ensuring students can recognise risk, challenge harmful behaviours and seek support. Health education reflects current guidance, including mental wellbeing, grief, loss and access to support services. All PSHE lessons explicitly signpost safeguarding support and reporting routes.

The curriculum is underpinned by the Equality Act and promotes a clear understanding of protected characteristics, diversity and inclusion. Students engage critically with local, national and global issues such as discrimination, human rights and environmental challenges, ensuring they are well prepared for life beyond school and the workplace, and able to contribute to an inclusive society.

A carefully sequenced and spiral curriculum ensures progression across Key Stages 3–5, revisiting key themes with increasing depth and complexity. Structured opportunities for age appropriate discussion, scenario-based learning, debate and reflection enable students to develop critical thinking and confidently engage with complex and sensitive issues.

Enrichment is a key strength of the PSHE programme. Students engage with a broad range of external visitors, workshops and real-life experiences that provide authentic context to learning. These include cultural visits, such as the Year 7 mosque and cathedral visit, as well as workshops focused on relationships, consent, safeguarding and personal safety. The curriculum is further strengthened through engagement with national and school-based initiatives, including volunteering opportunities, kindness and community activities, and mental health awareness, ensuring learning remains relevant and responsive.

The curriculum is inclusive and accessible to all learners. Adaptive teaching strategies ensure that students with SEND and EAL are fully supported through scaffolding, structured resources and explicit vocabulary instruction. Content reflects a diverse range of identities, cultures and lived experiences, ensuring representation while fostering mutual respect. Enrichment opportunities and experiences are provided free of charge wherever possible, ensuring equity of access and removing barriers to participation so that all students can engage and achieve.

The curriculum is continuously reviewed against statutory guidance to address emerging gaps, including developments in online safety legislation, harmful sexual behaviours and mental health risks. Ultimately, the PSHE/SMSC curriculum develops confident, resilient and informed individuals who are able to make safe, responsible decisions and contribute positively to society.

Key stage 4	By the end of Key Stage 3, students will have gained confidence in coping strategies for transitioning from Primary to Secondary school. They will develop an understanding of how to build their skills to support future career pathways. Students will have gained knowledge of how to maintain their physical and mental health, as well as an awareness of how to stay safe both in and beyond school, including how to recognise and respond to risks associated with online activity, social media, artificial intelligence and misinformation. Students will also develop an awareness of environmental challenges affecting the world today. They will gain an understanding of the protected characteristics and British Values, including how the UK has developed as a diverse society. In addition, students will be aware of issues affecting people globally, including modern slavery, FGM, forced marriage, and exploitation in both offline and online contexts.

By the end of Key Stage 4, students will be able to understand the difference between healthy and unhealthy relationships and know where to access support. They will recognise the importance of consent and develop an understanding of different family structures. Students will understand how both legal and illegal substances can impact physical and mental health, and where to seek help if needed. They will develop an awareness of key issues affecting society, including the refugee crisis, racism and homelessness in Britain, and will be prepared to manage modern financial challenges such as fraud, budgeting, banking and pensions. Students will understand how democracy works in Britain, how laws are made, and how to participate in local and general elections, including how they are protected under the Equality Act and the importance of British Values. Students will have developed a deeper understanding of how to identify, manage and respond to risk in both offline and online contexts, including exploitation, coercion and abuse. They will critically evaluate the impact of digital technologies, including artificial intelligence, recognising risks such as misinformation, online manipulation, financial scams and sexual exploitation. Students will understand how these risks link to wider safeguarding concerns, including Child Sexual Exploitation, and will be equipped with the knowledge and confidence to seek support, challenge harmful behaviours and make informed, responsible decisions.

	At Key Stage 5, the Personal Development curriculum prepares students for the transition to adulthood, higher education and the world of work by equipping them with the knowledge, skills and confidence needed to make informed, responsible decisions. Through a carefully sequenced programme covering personal finance, health and emotional wellbeing, relationships and sex education, equality, diversity, safety and risk awareness, students develop the resilience and independence required to thrive in modern society. The curriculum places a strong emphasis on inclusion, ensuring that all students develop an understanding of equality, protected characteristics, diversity and the value of different perspectives, experiences and identities. Students are encouraged to challenge discrimination, celebrate diversity and contribute positively to an inclusive and respectful community. Through discussion of real-life scenarios and contemporary issues, including the impact of digital technologies and artificial intelligence, students develop critical thinking, self-reflection and informed decision-making skills. They are empowered to manage personal risk, maintain positive physical and mental health, build healthy relationships, understand their rights and responsibilities, and develop the employability skills necessary for successful progression into further education, employment and independent living. Through this programme, students leave Key Stage 5 as confident, resilient and socially responsible young adults who value inclusion, demonstrate respect for others and are prepared to contribute positively to their communities and wider society.
