

Campsite Rules and Safety

The campsites we will be staying at are all family campsites. Each campsite will have its own set of rules that you must obey if you wish to remain on the site. If you are not willing to follow the rules of a campsite you, or our whole group, could be asked to leave.

Along with the rules set by the site there are certain expectations set by the school. If you are unable to follow the rules below you will be unable to continue your expedition, this is for your own safety and the safety of the other students. In this case we would ring your parents and ask that they collect you.

BA Campsite Rules

- No litter to be left while walking or on the campsite.
- No fires at all.
- Trangias (cookers) only to be used outside of tents.
- In tents and no noise after 10.30pm.
- Campsite facilities to be left clean.

BA Expedition Rules

- Groups must stay together while on expedition.
- Students must not cross a main road (red road) unless a member of staff is present.
- Groups should follow the country code at all times.
- Students are expected to behave in an appropriate manner at all times while on expedition.
- No phones are to be used during the expedition weekend.
